PAINT MIXING Cheat Sheet

HOW TO USE

This cheat sheet is based on my HomeRight Finish Max Super paint sprayer which recommends thinning 5% to 15%. It's best to start with the least amount necessary to properly thin the paint. Column A thins 5%. Column A plus column B thins 10%. Column A plus column B plus column C thins 15%.

Start by filling your sprayer container with your product (paint, stain, poly, etc.) and then add water or thinner based on the type of product you're using. For example, if you filled your container with 8 ounces of water-based paint, first add 2.5 teaspoons (column A) of water and test. If the paint is too thick add up to an additional 2.5 teaspoons (column B) of water. If the paint is still too thick add up to an additional 2.5 teaspoons (column c). Record your paint mix ratio below for future use.
